INSTITUTIONAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN

- 1. In the next five years, increase the number of students from the current 471 to 800 by offering PG courses and a variety of undergraduate course options.
- 2. To complete NAAC Accreditation process.
- 3. To allow permanent affiliation from the affiliating university to apply for 2 f (12 B).
- 4. The teaching staff will be encouraged to take part in more research-based events, such as conferences, faculty development programs, refresher courses, seminars, workshops, and capacity building initiatives pertaining to their pedagogy and areas of expertise.
- 5. The teaching faculty will be motivated in research by applying for research projects.
- 6. Computer Science, Physics, Chemistry, Psychology and Geography lab will upgraded with latest tools and equipments.
- 7. The library will be upgraded with a database online catalogue, online journal subscriptions, and a computer-equipped reading area in the library hall.
- 8. The library will be provided with internet access and e-resources, including video courses and online journals.
- 9. Student society interface will be improved through programmes like NSS, Red Cross, Women Cell and Earnwhile you learn schemes.
- 10. For efficient resource usage, the institute will empower rainwater harvesting, solar power, and waste management systems.
- 11. The institute will attempt to raise money for the college's development from a variety of sources, including alumni, Sarapanches from neighboring communities, and prominent members of the community.
