

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is executed on this ____ day of _____, 2025, by and between:

District Programme Officer (DPO), a key official responsible for implementing and managing specific government programs at the district level. They are essentially the on the ground leaders for these programs, ensuring they are effectively delivered and achieving their intended goals.

Government College for Women, Gurawara, Rewari, a government institution of higher education for women, affiliated with **Indira Gandhi University Meerpur, Rewari**, and functioning under the **Department of Higher Education, Government of Haryana** (hereinafter referred to as "the College").

Collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually as a "Party."

2. Objective of the MoU

The primary objective of this MOU is to provide access to training and certificate in the area of health and well-being of children and pregnant women for the students of government college for Women Gurawara, Rewari thereby enhancing their employability, awareness regarding health of children and pregnant women, and readiness for future careers.

This will be executed through District Programme Officer, Rewari, as they work closely with various stakeholders, including government departments, NGOs, and community organisations, to ensure program success.

To allow all Aanganbaris at different villages to provide internships to students.

3. Scope of Collaboration

Under this MoU, the following areas of cooperation are agreed upon:

- To keep students regarding various health programmes including non-communicable disease control, vaccination campaign, or sanitation.
- To teach students how to implement and manage the Integrated Child Development Services (ICDS) program, which provides services for children aged 0-6 years and pregnant and lactating mothers.
- To teach students regarding implementing the Poshan (Nutrition) program, which aims to improve the nutritional status of children and women and about other government initiatives related to education, social welfare, or rural development.

4. Roles and Responsibilities:

1. Deliver training programs to students through a training partner District Programme Officer (DPO).
2. Appoint trainers with expertise to ensure quality learning.
3. Provide certification to students after completing the courses.
4. Organize other capacity-building activities.

The College Shall:

1. Support in student mobilization by promoting training opportunities among enrolled students.
2. Designate a Nodal Officer to act as a point of contact and coordinate with District Programme Officer (DPO) for smooth implementation.
3. Facilitate training activities.

5. Duration of the MoU

This MoU will remain in effect for a period of three (3) years from the date of execution, unless terminated earlier by either party as per the terms mentioned below. It may be extended upon mutual consent in writing.

7. Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain confidentiality of proprietary information, student data, and training content.

8. Termination

Either party may terminate this MoU by providing **thirty (30) days written notice** to the other party. In the event of such termination, ongoing training courses shall continue till completion to avoid disruption for students.

10. Dispute Resolution

Any dispute arising out of the interpretation or implementation of this MoU shall be resolved amicably through mutual dialogue. If unresolved, the dispute shall be referred to the jurisdiction of courts in Rewari.

11. Amendment

Any modification or amendment to this MoU shall be made in writing and signed by authorized representatives of both parties.


